Subject : Compassionate Engagement against the post of Gramin Dak Sevaks- reg

I am directed to inform you that the Committee for Compassionate Engagement which met on 02.03.2020 and 03.03.2020 has considered 44 cases and recommended 38 cases on compassionate grounds in relaxation of normal recruitment rules. The details are as follows.

Annexure I: Cases recommended for compassionate engagement

Annexure II: Cases not recommended

Annexure III: Cases provisionally recommended subject to the approval of competent authority.

The minutes of the committee for compassionate engagement dated 02.03.2020 and 03.03.2020 has been approved by the competent authority and I am directed to communicate the following instructions.

1. The approved candidates may be engaged after observing usual pre-engagement formalities like issue of offer of engagement with the condition mentioned therein that it is subject to their satisfactory verification of character and antecedents by the District Authorities, Police Verification, Medical Examination, verification of educational certificates to the respective Board of Public Examinations/ Board of Higher Secondary Examinations and verification of community etc. Fresh community certificate should also be obtained. Before engagement, a declaration should be obtained from the candidate to the effect that he will take care of the family of the late official on getting employment. The date on which the provisional engagement orders are issued in respect of each candidate/ post should be reported to the Circle Office by 31.03.2020.

2. The instructions regarding production of certificate of 60 days course of computer knowledge should be ensured from all candidates approved for compassionate engagement before engaging them.
3. The approved candidates should be provided engagement against the post for which his/her candidature was approved by the competent authority.
4. It is the responsibility of the appointing authority to ensure genuineness of educational qualification of the candidate considered for compassionate engagement.
5. An entry may be made in the service records of the claimants under proper attestation to the effect that he/she has been engaged as GDS on compassionate grounds in relaxation of normal recruitment rules and this letter may be quoted as authority for the relaxation.

THE ORIGINAL CERTIFICATES SHOULD BE OBTAINED FROM THE CANDIDATE AND ITS GENUINNESS BE GOT VERIFIED WITH THE RESPECTIVE BOARDS/UNIVERSITIES, BEFORE APPOINTING THE CANDIDATE.

THE EXACT DATE OF ENGAGING SHOULD BE INTIMATED TO THIS OFFICE WITHOUT FAIL.

MINUTES OF THE COMMITTEE FOR COMPASSIONATE ENGAGEMENT(CCE)
MEETING HELD AT THE OFFICE OF CHIEF POSTMASTER GENERAL,
THIRUVANANTHAPURAM ON 02.03.2020 AND 03.03.2020

The Committee on Compassionate Engagement(CCE) comprising of the following members met on 02.03.2020 and 03.03.2020 at the office of the Chief Postmaster General, Kerala Circle, Thiruvananthapuram 695 033 to consider the requests of dependents of deceased Gramin Dak Sevaks for engagement as GDS on compassionate grounds in Kerala Postal Circle.

The committee has examined 44 cases including 4 CAT cases. While examining each case, the committee kept in view the guidelines contained in Letter No 17-1/2017-GDS dated 30.05.2017 and subsequent clarifications on the subject issued by the Postal Directorate from time to time.

Secondary School Examination pass certificate of 10th Standard conducted by a recognised Board of School Education in India shall be mandatory. There is no relaxation in basic educational qualification.

The candidates are also required to produce a certificate for undergoing basic computer training of at least 60 days duration from a recognised computer training institute.

There shall be no relaxation in age conditions as prescribed for reserved categories. However upper age limit could be relaxed wherever found to be necessary. Powers to relax upper age limit of the applicant is vested with the Head of Circle.

As per Directorate letter No.17-02/2018-GDS dated 08.03.2019 regarding the revised eligibility criteria for engagement to Gramin Dak Sevaks(GDS) posts, compulsory knowledge of local language is necessary. This criterion is followed in GDS online recruitment Cycle II. The Committee for Compassionate Engagement has examined 44 cases including 4 CAT cases. However, in respect of the following three cases (**Annexure-III**), the candidates have not studied local language i.,e Malayalam in SSC as one of the subject. However, it is noticed by the committee that in all the three cases, the death of the deceased is prior to issue of revised guidelines and the request for compassionate appointment was also submitted before the issue of above revised guidelines.



In the above three cases the committee has provisionally recommended the cases subject to the relaxation of local language criterion in the educational qualification by the competent authority.

Engagement of approved cases is subject to the fulfillment of all eligibility conditions including production of certificate in proof of having basic knowledge of computer which is mandatory requirement for engagement to the post of approved GDS posts vide Directorate letter no.17-39/6/2012-GDS dated 14.01.2015. The approved candidates should be engaged only after obtaining the required certificates duly verified, as per Directorate letter no.17-39/2012-GDS dated 20.05.2016. Before issuing engagement order, the Divisional Head should ensure that the approved candidates fulfill the condition of possessing basic knowledge of computer, which is a mandatory requirement for recruitment to GDS posts.

The Divisional Head shall issue engagement order only after verifying all the eligibility conditions/ documents/ certificates. The approval is subject to the condition that the approved candidate will maintain the dependent family members of the deceased Gramin Dak Sevaks.

Keeping in view the guidelines governing the scheme of compassionate engagement in Directorate letter no.17-1/2017-GDS dated 30.05.2017, the committee/ competent authority has examined 44 cases including 4 CAT cases and recommended/approved 35cases as mentioned in **Annexure-I**. The Post against which the compassionate engagement is considered is also indicated against each. These posts are identified by the concerned Divisional Heads.

The committee/ Competent authority has not recommended / rejected 6 cases for the reasons mentioned against each case as shown in **Annexure-II**.

The committee has observed that some proposals have been received from the Regions and Divisions without the recommendation of the Regional PMG/ Divisional Head. Hence forth only duly recommended cases for compassionate appointment/ engagement should be forwarded to the Circle Office for the examination of Circle Relaxation Committees.

COURT CASES


1. Shri.Jiji P Raveendran, S/o Late P R Raveendran, GDS MC Manjoor South PO

Orders dated 04.01.2019 of Hon'ble CAT in OA 556/2016

In connection with the compassionate engagement of Shri.Jiji P Raveendran, S/o Late P R Raveendran, GDS MC, Manjoor South PO who expired on 05.02.2013, the applicant who is the second son of the deceased has filed an OA No.556/2016 at CAT Ernakulam aggrieved on non consideration of his request for compassionate engagement. The elder brother of the applicant was absconding w.e.f. 12.06.2011 (before the death of the GDS). FIR has been prepared by Kaduthuruthi Police Station on 08.03.2019 in this regard and investigation is going on. OA 556/2016 was disposed by Hon'ble Tribunal vide its order dated 04.01.2019 directing the applicant to provide all relevant records including information in respect of missing brother so that a considered view could be taken by the CRC.

In order to comply with the orders of Hon'ble CAT, the present committee examined the case and found that consent of all eligible family members is not produced by the claimant. It is seen that the FIR has been lodged by the police only on 08.03.2019, months before the holding of this meeting when the missing happened during 2011. The compassionate appointment is largely related to the need for immediate assistance to the family of the GDS in order to relieve it from economic distress. The very fact that the family has been able to manage somehow for long should normally be taken as adequate proof that the family had some dependable means of subsistence. Sri Jinu PR, elder son of the deceased is also an eligible dependant and his right for the job cannot be denied.


The applicant failed to produce required documents to the satisfactory level of this committee and the committee in humble obedience to the Hon'ble Tribunal vide its order dated 04.01.2019 has examined the case and not recommended/ rejected the case.


2. Smt.Ammi Ammal, W/o Late V.S.Rajappan Pillai who worked as GDS MD, Vellappore PO, Pathanamthitta Dn

Order dated 19.12.2018 of the Hon'ble Tribunal passed in OA No. 221/2018

Sri.V S Rajappan Pillai while working as GDS MD, Vellappore P O under Pathanamthitta Division expired on 06.02.2011. Shri.Renjith Kumar, son of the deceased applied for compassionate engagement in 2012. The Circle Relaxation Committee which met on 30.09.2013/01.10.2013 duly analysed the request but did not recommend the case due to less indigent status of the family and rejected his request for compassionate engagement. On 23.08.2014, Smt.Ammi Ammal.S, wife of the deceased submitted a request seeking employment assistance for herself. As the request of the dependents(son of the deceased) had already been considered and rejected, re-opening of the case in the name of another applicant defeats the purpose of the scheme for compassionate engagement. While submitting his request for compassionate engagement, Shri.Renjith Kumar.R has stated that his mother is a chronic patient who is unable to undertake any arduous nature of duties. After the rejection of his request for compassionate engagement, the widow came up with her request. Therefore, Smt.Ammi Ammal was informed vide this office letter No.Recttt /7-3/GDS/2013 dated 12.03.2018 that her request cannot be acceded to as the case already stands rejected. Aggrieved over

the above decision OA.No.221/2018 was filed by Smt.Ammi Ammal in the Hon'ble CAT, Ernakulam bench and the CAT vide its order dated 19.12.2018 has directed the respondents to consider the Smt.Ammi Ammal's case in the next CRC meeting independent of the rejection of her son's application.

In order to comply with the orders of Hon'ble CAT, the present committee examined the case and the observations are as follows.

- (i) The applicant, aged 59 years, is too old and not found suitable for the post in all respects as per prescribed conditions. A person selected to the post of GDS has to undertake new kind of works that department undertake such as RICT, IPPB, RPLI etc., Recommending a person not found suitable for the job is against public interest as it will not be justifying the job. Also, the compassionate appointment is largely related to the need for immediate assistance to the family of the GDS in order to relieve it from economic distress.
- (ii) The very fact that the family has been able to manage somehow for a long period from the date of death of the GDS should also normally be taken as adequate proof that the family had some dependable means of subsistence.

The committee thread-bare analysed the case and in view of para (i) and (ii) above the case is not recommended/ rejected.


3. Smt.Jijimol, D/o late Shri.K P Peethambaran, GDS MD II, Thalanad in Kottayam Dn.

Orders dated 10.03.2017 OA 365/2016 before Hon'ble CAT Ernakulam bench

Shri.K P Peethambaran, GDS MD II, Thalanad in Kottayam Dn. expired on 04.09.2014. Smt. KP Jijimol daughter of the deceased applied for compassionate appointment on 09.09.2015 and the Committee constituted for considering the compassionate engagement dated 23.11.2016 analysed the request and rejected due to less indigent status of the family.

Aggrieved over the rejection by the CCE, she filed OA 185/2017 and the Hon'ble Tribunal vide its order dated 10.03.2017 directed the respondents not to dispense with the applicant's service as a substitute. The Hon'ble Tribunal has disposed of the OA by order dated 06.04.2018 and directed the respondents for re consideration and directed the applicant to produce the documents before the respondents.

In this connection, request for re-consideration of compassionate engagement of Smt.Jijimol KP has been received from the RO Kochi. The deceased GDS is survived with wife Smt PK Leela and 4 daughters. The elder daughter Smt.Jijimol KP (currently aged 40) is the applicant and wholly dependent on the father at the time of death.

In order to comply with the orders of Hon'ble CAT, the present committee examined the case and recommended the case for compassionate engagement.


4. Smt. Sreelatha Prasannan, wife of Sri. Prasannan Pillai, GDS BPM, Pallickal Noornad P O under Mavelikkara Division


Order dated 09.10.2018 of the Hon'ble Tribunal passed in OA No. 180/00827/2018.

Sri. Prasannan Pillai while working as GDS BPM, Pallickal Noornad P O under Mavelikkara Division expired on 14.05.2018. The late GDS, Shri.Prasannan Pillai had legally separated from his first wife and married to Smt. Sreelatha on 17.01.2008. The first wife is still alive and she got married to another person. The late GDS left behind a son(Shri.M.P.Zenkumar) with his first wife. The second wife of the deceased GDS had two sons before marrying to Shri.Prasannan Pillai. Shri. Midhun M elder son of Smt. Sreelatha Prasannan is employed in Army and living separately. Her younger son Shri.Sachin is a graduate student and living along with the family.

Smt. Sreelatha Prasannan, wife of the deceased had applied for employment assistance under compassionate grounds on 28.07.2018 and subsequently approached the Hon'ble CAT and filed OA No.180/00827/2018 with a request to grant immediate engagement as GDS on provisional basis to the applicant. The Hon'ble CAT, Ernakulam bench disposed of the OA directing the respondents to consider and dispose the representations submitted by the applicant. In humble obedience to the directions of the Hon'ble Tribunal in its order dated 09.10.2018 in OA No. 180/00827/2018, Chief

PMG has considered the representation of the applicant along with other Annexures and connected records of the case. It was seen that the applicant has not submitted any formal proposal for employment assistance under compassionate grounds till the date of receipt of order of the Hon'ble Tribunal.

The application and the supporting documents for compassionate appointment from Smt.Sreelatha Prasannan, wife of the late GDS, Shri.Prasannan Pillai were collected. As per extant rulings, the dependents of the deceased may not be engaged till the case is cleared by the Circle Relaxation Committee and approved by the Competent Authority.


The representation of Smt.Sreelatha Prasannan, wife of the late GDS, Shri.A.M.Prasannan Pillai seeking compassionate appointment was considered by the Chief PMG with reference to the above facts and her engagement as GDS will be subject to the outcome of Circle Relaxation Committee. Meanwhile the applicant filed MA No.851/19 in OA No.827/18 for implementation of order dated 09.10.2018 in OA No.827/2018.

In order to comply with the orders of Hon'ble CAT, the present committee examined the case and observed that there are two claimants for compassionate engagement. The son of the late GDS, born to the first wife also had equal right for compassionate engagement as he is the legitimate child. As Shri.Zenkumar, legitimate son of the deceased GDS has not given any consent for offering compassionate engagement to his stepmother, the committee has analysed that offering a job to the applicant without the consent of eligible family members is against to natural justice. Taking into consideration of all the facts and indigent status of the family the committee has observed that the family does not deserve immediate assistance of relief in the form of compassionate engagement. The case was not recommended / rejected.

The Committee for Compassionate engagement has considered 44 cases including 4 CAT cases. Out of 4 court cases 2 cases are considered for the first time. The committee has recommended 35 Cases for engagement under compassionate grounds and furnished as Annexure I.


