In pursuance to Directorate letter No. A-34012/05/2020-DE dated 04.11.2020, Limited Departmental Competitive Examination (LDCE) for promotion of eligible officials working in C.O./R.O to the cadre of Postal Assistants, Circle Office/ Regional Office for Departmental quota of vacancies for the year 2020 was conducted on 20.12.2020. Data Entry Skill Test (DEST/Paper-III) for the candidates who qualified in Paper-I and Paper-II of the examination was conducted on 11.04.2021.

2. Now the Competent Authority is pleased to announce the result of the LDCE held on 20.12.2020 and DEST held on 11.04.2021. The names and designation of candidates, declared successful for promotion to the cadre of Postal Assistant (CO-RO) is given below.

The candidates in the list published vide this office letter of even number dated 01.04.2021, who qualified in Paper-III have been considered for final selection and their merit is drawn in order of marks secured in Paper-I. Since Paper-II and Paper-III are only qualifying, marks secured in Paper-II and Paper-III was not added to the marks secured in Paper-I to decide the merit.

4. In case, it is subsequently found that any of the selected candidate(s) was not eligible to take the examination under the extant rules or instructions on the subject or for any other reason or in case any mistake is found with regard to announcement of result of any candidate for any reason whatsoever, his/ her name will be deleted from the list of successful candidates, as the case may be. This should be incorporated in the promotion/ appointment letters issued.



5. This result is further subject to outcome of various cases pending before the Hon'ble Court/ CAT


6. If any vigilance/disciplinary case is pending against any of the candidates, they should not be relieved for posting without obtaining specific orders from this office. If any punishment is in currency, in respect of any of the candidates, he/she should not be promoted before the expiry of the currency of punishment.

7. It may be ensured that appointment orders are issued to the candidate(s) within 15 days by reporting compliance.
